Your Question: I am a former Lafitte resident. If HUD/HANO offers me a unit at Iberville, can I turn down that unit without penalty from HUD/HANO?

HUD/HANO's Answer: Lafitte residents who are offered an alternative unit at the Iberville development, are not required to accept the alternative unit. They can remain on their assistance program without revocation of that assistance.

Your Question: I am a former Lafitte resident. If I accept an offer to live in Iberville, will HUD/HANO let me return to Lafitte when repaired and/or redeveloped units are ready there?

HUD/HANO's Answer: Accepting an alternative unit does not prohibit your return to the original development once it is redeveloped or other units become available.
